

DEMOCRACY AND BOUNDARY COMMISSION CYMRU ETC. ACT 2013

The Conwy (Communities) Order 2026

Made - - - - [27/05/2026]

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Conwy County Borough Council (“the Council”) has, in accordance with section 25 of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013 (“the 2013 Act”), submitted to the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru (“the Commission”) a report dated January 2025 on its review of, and recommendations for changes to, community arrangements in the County Borough of Conwy.

The Commission has agreed to give effect to the Council’s recommendations without modifications.

More than six weeks have elapsed since the Council’s recommendations were submitted to the Commission.

The Commission makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred on it by section 38(1) of the 2013 Act.

Title and commencement

1.–(1) The title of this Order is the Conwy (Communities) Order 2026.

(2) This Order comes into force at the next local government election.

Interpretation

2. In this Order–

“Map A” means the map deposited by the Commission with Conwy County Borough Council and reproduced for reference in Schedule 1 to this Order;

“Map B” means the map deposited by the Commission with Conwy County Borough Council and reproduced for reference in Schedule 2 to this Order;

where a boundary is shown on a map as running along a road, railway line, footway, watercourse or similar geographical feature, it is to be treated as running along the centre line of the feature;

words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as they have in Part 3 of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013, except so far as a contrary intention appears.

Local government area changes

3. Changes are made in the local government area of the County Borough of Conwy in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.

Town of Llandudno – change to town ward areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements

4. The part of the town ward of Mostyn shown shaded in purple on Map A:

- (a) is transferred to the town ward of Tudno; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Tudno.

5. The part of the town ward of Tudno shown shaded in blue on Map B:

- (a) is transferred to the town ward of Craig y Don; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Craig-y-Don.

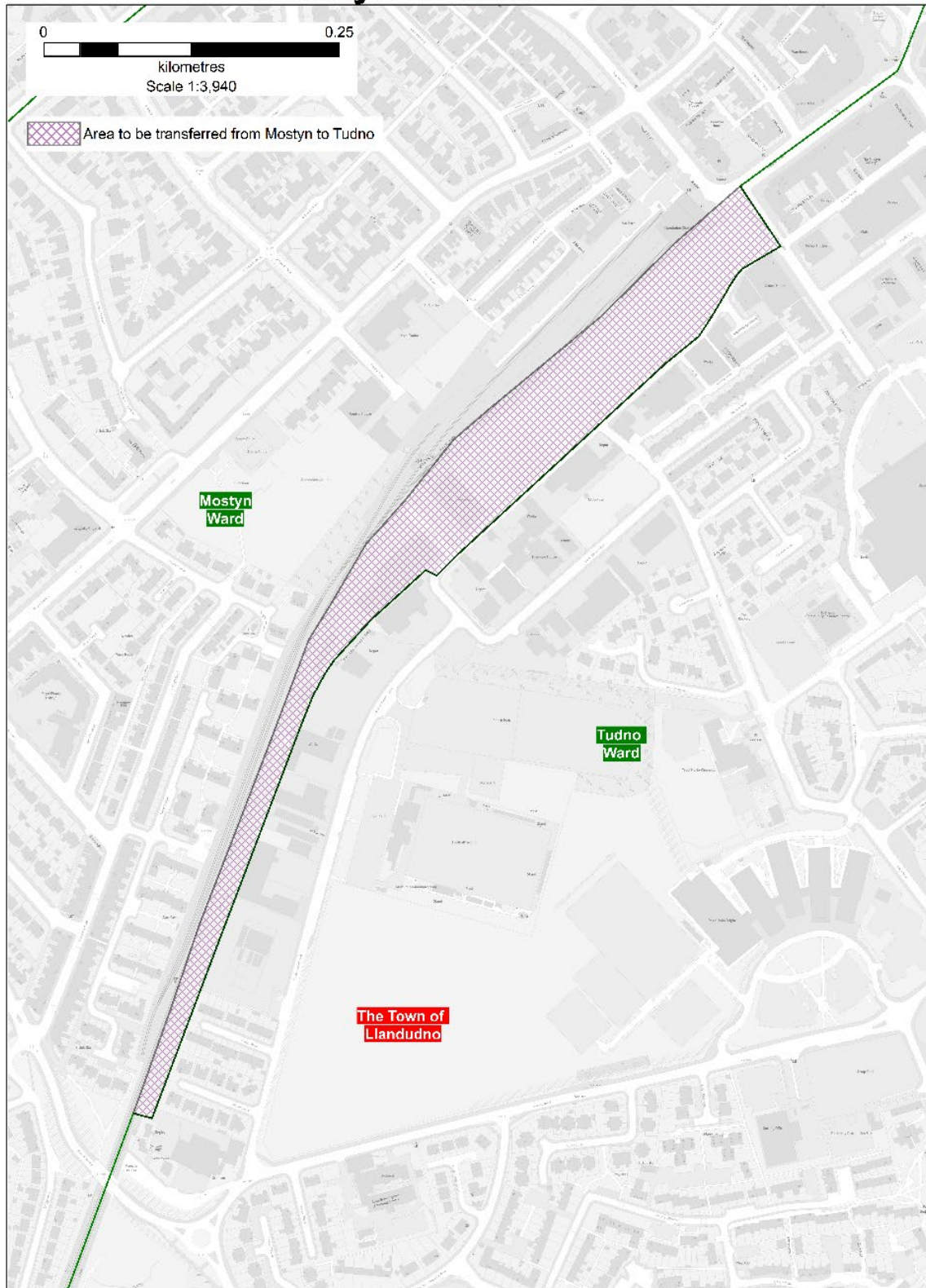

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, made in accordance with section 38(1) of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013 (“the 2013 Act”), gives effect to recommendations made by Conwy County Borough Council (“the Council”). The Council reported in March 2026 on its review under section 25 of the 2013 Act of community boundaries.

The report recommended changes to the boundaries of the town wards of Craig y Don, Mostyn, and Tudno of the Town of Llandudno. This order makes changes to the boundaries of those town wards.

The report recommended no changes to the names of communities and electoral wards, the existing names have been given in the maps.
