**The County of Ceredigion (Communities) Order 2026**

Made - - - - 17 March 2026  
Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)  
and (3)

The Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru<sup>(1)</sup> (“the Commission”) has, under section 36(5)(a) of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013<sup>(2)</sup> (“the 2013 Act”), submitted to the Welsh Ministers a report dated October 2024 containing its recommendations for change and the details of a review of the community arrangements within the County of Ceredigion.

The Welsh Ministers, after consideration of the matters referred to and set out in section 37(2)(b) and (c) of the 2013 Act, have decided to give effect to the Commission’s recommendations with modification. The Welsh Ministers also make supplemental provision as considered necessary or expedient.

Under section 37(3A) and (3B) of the 2013 Act<sup>(3)</sup>, more than 6 weeks have elapsed since those recommendations were submitted to the Welsh Ministers.

The Welsh Ministers have published a statement setting out their decision in respect of each recommendation under section 37(6) of the 2013 Act<sup>(4)</sup>.

The Welsh Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 37(1) and 40(1) and (2)(a) and (b) of the 2013 Act.

Under section 37(2A) of the 2013 Act<sup>(5)</sup>, the Welsh Ministers make this Order more than 6 months preceding the day of an ordinary council election under section 26 of the Local Government Act 1972<sup>(6)</sup>.

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- (1) The Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales was established by section 53 of, and Schedule 8 to, the Local Government Act 1972 (c. 70). Section 53 and Schedule 8 were repealed by section 73(2) of, and Schedule 2 to, the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Act 2013 (anaw 4) (“the 2013 Act”). The 2013 Act renamed the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales as the Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales (see section 2(2)). The Senedd Cymru (Members and Elections) Act 2024 (asc 4) renamed the Local Democracy and Boundary Commission for Wales as the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru (see section 12).
- (2) 2013 anaw 4. Section 11 of the Senedd Cymru (Members and Elections) Act 2024 renamed the short title of the 2013 Act as the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013.
- (3) Section 37(3A) and (3B) was substituted for section 37(3) of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013 by section 43(2) of the Elections and Elected Bodies (Wales) Act 2024 (asc 5).
- (4) Section 37(6) was inserted by section 49(2)(b) of the Elections and Elected Bodies (Wales) Act 2024.
- (5) Section 37(2A) was inserted by section 47(3) of the Elections and Elected Bodies (Wales) Act 2024.

## Title and coming into force

1.—(1) The title of this Order is the County of Ceredigion (Communities) Order 2026.

(2) For any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) of the 1976 Regulations<sup>(7)</sup>, this Order comes into force on 6 May 2026.

(3) For all other purposes, this Order comes into force at 23:59 hours on the day before the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2027.

## Interpretation

2.—(1) In this Order—

“the 1972 Act” (“*Deddf 1972*”) means the Local Government Act 1972<sup>(8)</sup>;

“the 1976 Regulations” (“*Rheoliadau 1976*”) means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976;

“electoral ward” (“*ward etholiadol*”) means any area for which councillors are elected to Ceredigion County Council;

“existing” (“*presennol*”) means a community, community ward or community council as it exists immediately before the time and day set out in article 1(3);

“new” (“*newydd*”) means a community, community ward or community council established by this Order;

any reference to a map means one of the 81 maps marked “Map of the County of Ceredigion (Communities) Order 2026”, deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the 1976 Regulations, labelled “1” to “81”, and a reference to a numbered map is a reference to the map that bears that number;

where a boundary is shown on a map as running along a road, railway line, footway, watercourse or similar geographical feature, it must be treated as running along the centre line of the feature.

(2) The provisions in this Order take precedence over any conflicting provision in any previous statutory instrument made under section 58(2) of the 1972 Act or order made under sections 37(1), 38(1) or 39(1) of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013.

**24.** The part of the existing Silian community ward of the existing community of Llangybi shown shaded on Map 14—

- (a) is transferred to the community of Lampeter;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Lampeter.

### **Llandysul, and Llandyfriog — changes in community and community ward boundaries, and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

### **Blaenrheidol and Pontarfynach — abolition of the communities of Blaenrheidol and Pontarfynach, and consequential changes to community councils**

**70.** The existing community council of Blaenrheidol is dissolved.

**71.** The community of Pontarfynach as changed by this Order is abolished.

- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 3 on Map 71;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Llanwenog.

### **Llanfihangel Ystrad — establishment of new community council and community electoral arrangements**

**216.** In the new community of Llanfihangel Ystrad, the number of councillors to be elected for the new community ward of—

- (a) Dihewyd is 3;

### **Llanfihangel Ystrad — electoral ward arrangements**

**217.** The electoral ward of Llanfihangel Ystrad comprises the new Dihewyd and Llanfihangel Ystrad community wards of the new community of Llanfihangel Ystrad.

**218.** In the electoral ward of Llanfihangel Ystrad, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.

**219.** The electoral ward of Llanwenog comprises the new Llanwnnen community ward of the new community of Llanfihangel Ystrad, and the community of Llanwenog.

**220.** In the electoral ward of Llanwenog, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.

### **Llangoedmor — changes in community boundaries and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**221.** The part of the community of Llangoedmor shown shaded on Map 72—

- (a) is transferred to the community of Y Ferwig;

- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Aberporth and Y Ferwig.

#### **Llangoedmor — community electoral arrangements**

- 222.** In the community of Llangoedmor, the number of councillors to be elected is 7.

#### **Llangrannog and Penbryn — changes in community ward boundaries**

- 223.** The part of the existing community of Llangrannog shown shaded on Map 73—
  - (a) is transferred to the existing community of Penbryn;
  - (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Penbryn.

#### **Llangrannog and Penbryn — abolition of the communities of Llangrannog and Penbryn, and consequential changes to community councils**

- 224.** The community of Llangrannog as changed by this Order is abolished.
- 225.** The existing community council of Llangrannog is dissolved.
- 226.** The community of Penbryn as changed by this Order is abolished.
- 227.** The existing community council of Penbryn is dissolved.

#### **Creation of the new community of Llangrannog and Penbryn**

- 228.** A new community is created which is to be known as Llangrannog and Penbryn in the English language and Llangrannog a Phenbryn in the Welsh language and which—
  - (a) comprises the area shown shaded on Map 74;

**235.** The part of the existing Gwnnws Isaf community ward of the existing community of Ystrad Meurig shown shaded on Map 75—

- (a) is transferred to the existing community of Trawsgoed;
- (b) forms part of the existing community ward of Llanafan;
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Ystwyth.

#### **Llanilar and Trawsgoed — abolition of the communities of Llanilar and Trawsgoed, and consequential changes to community councils**

**236.** The community of Llanilar as changed by this Order is abolished.

**237.** The existing community council of Llanilar is dissolved.

**238.** The existing community of Trawsgoed as changed by this Order is abolished.

**239.** The existing community council of Trawsgoed is dissolved.

#### **Creation of the new community of Ystwyth**

**240.** A new community is created which is to be known as Ystwyth in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

- (a) comprises the area shown shaded on Map 76;
- (b) forms the electoral ward of Ystwyth.

#### **Creation of the new community ward of Llanilar**

**241.** A new community ward is created in the new community of Ystwyth which is to be known as Llanilar in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 1 on Map 76;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Ystwyth.

#### **Creation of the new community ward of Trawsgoed**

**242.** A new community ward is created in the new community of Ystwyth which is to be known as Trawsgoed in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 2 on Map 76;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Ystwyth.

### **Ystwyth — establishment of new community council and community ward electoral arrangements**

**243.** A council for the new community of Ystwyth is established.

**244.** In the new community of Ystwyth, the number of councillors to be elected for the new community ward of—

- (a) Llanilar is 7;
- (b) Trawsgoed is 6.

### **Ystwyth — electoral ward arrangements**

**245.** The electoral ward of Ystwyth comprises the area of the new community of Ystwyth.

**246.** In the electoral ward of Ystwyth, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.

### **Llansantffraid — change of community name**

**247.** The community of Llansantffraid as changed by this Order is to be known as Llansanffraid in the English language and the Welsh language.

### **Llansanffraid — community electoral arrangements**

**248.** In the community of Llansanffraid, the number of councillors to be elected is 8.

### **Melindwr — abolition of community wards**

**249.** The following existing community wards of the community of Melindwr are abolished—

- (a) Goginan;
- (b) Llanbadarn y Creuddyn Uchaf;
- (c) Penllwyn.

### **Melindwr — community electoral arrangements**

**250.** In the community of Melindwr, the number of councillors to be elected is 7.

### **Tirymynach and Geneu'r Glyn — changes in community ward boundaries and community boundaries**

**251.** The part of the existing community of Geneu'r Glyn shown shaded on Map 77—

- (a) is transferred to the existing community of Tirymynach;
- (b) forms part of the existing community ward of Tirymynach;
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Tirymynach.

**252.** The part of the community of Borth shown shaded on Map 78—

- (a) is transferred to the existing community of Geneu'r Glyn;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Borth.

**253.** The part of the existing Tirymynach community ward of the existing community of Tirymynach shown shaded on Map 79—

- (a) is transferred to the community of Trefeurig;

- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Trefeurig.

**Tirymynach and Geneu'r Glyn — abolition of the communities of Tirymynach and Geneu'r Glyn, and consequential changes to community councils**

- 254.** The community of Tirymynach as changed by this Order is abolished.
- 255.** The existing community council of Tirymynach is dissolved.
- 256.** The community of Geneu'r Glyn as changed by this order is abolished.
- 257.** The existing community council of Geneu'r Glyn is dissolved.

**Creation of the new community of Tirymynach**

- 258.** A new community is created which is to be known as Tirymynach in the English language and the Welsh language and which—
- (a) comprises the area shown shaded on Map 80;
- (b) forms the electoral ward of Tirymynach and part of the electoral ward of Borth.

**Creation of the new community ward of Tirymynach**

- 259.** A new community ward is created in the new community of Tirymynach which is to be known as Tirymynach in the English language and the Welsh language and which—
- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 1 on Map 80;
- (b) forms the electoral ward of Tirymynach.

**Creation of the new community ward of Geneu'r Glyn**

- 260.** A new community ward is created in the new community of Tirymynach which is to be known as Geneu'r Glyn in the English language and Genau'r-glyn in the Welsh language and which—
- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 2 on Map 80;
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Borth.

**Tirymynach — establishment of new community council and community electoral arrangements**

- 261.** A council for the new community of Tirymynach is established.
- 262.** In the new community of Tirymynach, the number of councillors to be elected for the new community ward of—
- (a) Geneu'r Glyn is 4;
- (b) Tirymynach is 10.

**Tirymynach — electoral ward arrangements**

- 263.** The electoral ward of Tirymynach comprises the new Tirymynach community ward of the new community of Tirymynach.
- 264.** In the electoral ward of Tirymynach, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.
- 265.** The electoral ward of Borth comprises the new Geneu'r Glyn community ward of the new community of Tirymynach and the community of Borth.

266. In the electoral ward of Borth, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.

#### **Borth — change of community name**

267. The community of Borth as changed by this Order is to retain the name of Borth in the English language and is to be known as Y Borth in the Welsh language.

#### **Borth — community electoral arrangements**

268. In the community of Borth, the number of councillors to be elected is 8.

#### **Trefeurig — community electoral arrangements**

269. In the community of Trefeurig, the number of councillors to be elected is 8.

#### **Y Ferwig — community electoral arrangements**

270. In the community of Y Ferwig, the number of councillors to be elected is 8.

#### **Ystrad Fflur, Ysbyty Ystwyth and Ystrad Meurig — abolition of the communities of Ystrad Fflur, Ysbyty Ystwyth and Ystrad Meurig, and consequential changes to community councils**

271. The existing community of Ystrad Fflur is abolished.

272. The existing community council of Ystrad Fflur is dissolved.

273. The community of Ysbyty Ystwyth as changed by this Order is abolished.

274. The existing community council of Ysbyty Ystwyth is dissolved.

275. The community of Ystrad Meurig as changed by this Order is abolished.

276. The existing community council of Ystrad Meurig is dissolved.

#### **Creation of the new community of Ystrad Fflur**

277. A new community is created which is to be known as Ystrad Fflur in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

(a) comprises the area shown shaded on Map 81;

(b) forms part of the electoral ward of Tregaron and Ystrad Fflur and part of the electoral ward of Lledrod.

#### **Creation of the new community ward of Ysbyty Ystwyth**

278. A new community ward is created in the new community of Ystrad Fflur which is to be known as Ysbyty Ystwyth in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

(a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 1 on Map 81;

(b) forms part of the electoral ward of Lledrod.

#### **Creation of the new community ward of Ystrad Fflur**

279. A new community ward is created in the new community of Ystrad Fflur which is to be known as Ystrad Fflur in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

(a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 2 on Map 81;

- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Tregaron and Ystrad Fflur.

### Creation of the new community ward of Ystrad Meurig

**280.** A new community ward is created in the new community of Ystrad Fflur which is to be known as Ystrad Meurig in the English language and the Welsh language and which—

- (a) comprises the area shown shaded and numbered 3 on Map 81;  
 (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Lledrod.

### Ystrad Fflur — establishment of new community council and community ward electoral arrangements

**281.** A council for the new community of Ystrad Fflur is established.

**282.** In the new community of Ystrad Fflur, the number of councillors to be elected for the new community ward of—

- (a) Ysbyty Ystwyth is 4;  
 (b) Ystrad Fflur is 6;  
 (c) Ystrad Meurig is 4.

### Ystrad Fflur — electoral ward arrangements

**283.** The electoral ward of Tregaron and Ystrad Fflur comprises the new Ystrad Fflur community ward of the new community of Ystrad Fflur and the community of Tregaron.

**284.** In the electoral ward of Tregaron and Ystrad Fflur, the number of councillors to be elected is 1.

### Initial expenses etc. of new community councils

**285.—(1)** In this article—

- “the 1992 Act” (“*Deddf 1992*”) means the Local Government Finance Act 1992<sup>(9)</sup>;  
 “the prospective billing authority” (“*yr awdurdod bilio arfaethedig*”) means Ceredigion County Council;  
 “the relevant financial year” (“*y flwyddyn ariannol berthnasol*”) means the financial year beginning 1 April 2027.

(2) For the relevant financial year, section 32 of the 1992 Act (calculation of budget requirements by billing authorities) applies to the new community councils and the prospective billing authority but as if—

- (a) in making a calculation under section 32(2)(a) of the 1992 Act—  
 (i) the amount notified under paragraph (6) of this article were an item mentioned in section 35(1) of the 1992 Act (special items) relating to the new community, and

- (ii) the area of the prospective billing authority included the new community;
- (b) subsection (6) were omitted.

(3) For the relevant financial year, section 41 of the 1992 Act (issue of precepts by local precepting authorities) applies to the new community councils and the prospective billing authority but as if the prospective billing authority, in making calculations under section 32 of the 1992 Act (originally or by way of substitution) in its estimate under section 32(2)(a) were required to take into account an amount equal to that notified to it under paragraph (6) of this article.

(4) For the relevant financial year, sections 52X(1) (calculations to be net of precepts) and 52Y(2) (information for purposes of Chapter 4A) of the 1992 Act apply to the new community councils and the prospective billing authority but as if the aggregate amount of precepts anticipated by the prospective billing authority under regulations made under section 41 of the 1992 Act included the amounts notified to the new community councils under paragraph (6) of this article.

(5) In relation to the relevant financial year, section 50 of the 1992 Act (calculation of budget requirement by local precepting authorities) applies to the new community councils and the prospective billing authority as if each of the new community councils were required to secure that the amount calculated as its budget requirement for that year does not exceed the amount notified to that new community council under paragraph (6) of this article.

(6) The appropriate amount to be notified to each of the new community councils under this paragraph must be notified by the Welsh Ministers in writing to the prospective billing authority and to each of the new community councils.

(7) For the relevant financial year, the Local Authorities (Precepts) (Wales) Regulations 1995<sup>(10)</sup> apply to the new community councils and the prospective billing authority as if—

- (a) regulation 5 (information on schedules of payment) were omitted;
- (b) in paragraph 8 of the Schedule (rules for determination of schedules in instalments)—
  - (i) in sub-paragraphs (1), (2) and (3), the words after the first reference to “that financial year” were omitted;
  - (ii) in sub-paragraph (1)(a), the reference to “April” were a reference to “May”.

### **New community councils**

**286.** The proper officer of Ceredigion County Council must convene the first meeting of each of the new community councils established by articles 44, 76, 92, 111, 133, 147, 161, 173, 187, 202, 215, 231, 243, 261 and 281.

### **New community councils — residuary successors**

**287.** For the purposes of any provision of the 1976 Regulations which refers to the residuary successor of a dissolved authority—

- (a) for the existing community councils of New Quay and Llanllwchaiarn, the new community council of the new community of New Quay is specified as the residuary successor;
- (b) for the existing community councils of Blaenrheidol and Pontarfynach, the new community council of the new community of Blaenrheidol and Pontarfynach is specified as the residuary successor;

- (c) for the existing community councils of Llangynfelyn and Ysgubor-y-coed, the new community council of the new community of Llangynfelyn and Ysgubor-y-coed is specified as the residuary successor;
- (d) for the existing community councils of Ciliau Aeron and Nantcwnlle, the new community council of the new community of Ciliau Aeron and Nantcwnlle is specified as the residuary successor;
- (e) for the existing community councils of Henfynyw and Llannarth, the new community council of the new community of Henfynyw and Llannarth is specified as the residuary successor;
- (f) for the existing community councils of Llanddewi Brefi and Llangeitho, the new community council of the new community of Llangeitho is specified as the residuary successor;
- (g) for the existing community councils of Llanfair Clydogau and Llanybi, the new community council of the new community of Llanybi is specified as the residuary successor;
- (h) for the existing community councils of Lledrod and Llangwryfon, the new community council of the new community of Lledrod is specified as the residuary successor;
- (i) for the existing community councils of Llandysiliogogo and Troedyrour, the new community council of the new community of Llandysiliogogo and Troed-yr-aur is specified as the residuary successor;
- (j) for the existing community councils of Llanfarian and Llanrhystyd, the new community council of the new community of Llanfarian and Llanrhystud is specified as the residuary successor;
- (k) for the existing community councils of Llanfihangel Ystrad and Llanwnnen, the new community council of the new community of Llanfihangel Ystrad is specified as the residuary successor;
- (l) for the existing community councils of Llangrannog and Penbryn, the new community council of the new community of Llangrannog and Penbryn is specified as the residuary successor;
- (m) for the existing community councils of Llanilar and Trawsgoed, the new community council of the new community of Ystwyth is specified as the residuary successor;
- (n) for the existing community councils of Tirymynach and Geneu'r Glyn, the new community council of the new community of Tirymynach is specified as the residuary successor;
- (o) for the existing community councils of Ystrad Fflur, Ysbyty Ystwyth and Ystrad Meurig, the new community council of the new community of Ystrad Fflur is specified as the residuary successor.

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## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order implements the recommendations of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru (“the Commission”), which reported in October 2024 on its review of the community electoral arrangements in the County of Ceredigion. The Commission’s report recommended changes to the existing boundaries of communities within the area of the County of Ceredigion and consequential changes to electoral arrangements. This Order implements the Commission’s recommendations with modification. This Order also makes supplemental provision as considered necessary or expedient by the Welsh Ministers in relation to some community names.

The effect of this Order is to make changes to a number of communities and consequential changes to electoral arrangements. This Order also abolishes a number of existing communities and community wards, dissolves their community councils and creates new communities, new community wards and new community councils. This Order also makes administrative provision for the operation of, and setting of precepts relating to, those new community councils.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 referred to in article 2 of this Order contain incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as this.

The Welsh Ministers’ Code of Practice on the carrying out of Regulatory Impact Assessments was considered in relation to this Order. As a result, it was not considered necessary to carry out a regulatory impact assessment as to the likely costs and benefits of complying with this Order.
