

# DEMOCRACY AND BOUNDARY COMMISSION CYMRU ETC. ACT 2013

## The Rhondda Cynon Taf (Communities) Order 2025

*Made* - - - - - [21/10/2025]

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council (“the Council”) has, in accordance with section 25 of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013 (“the 2013 Act”), submitted to the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru (“the Commission”) a report dated 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 on its review of, and recommendations for changes to, community arrangements in the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf.

The Commission has agreed to give effect to the Council’s recommendations without modifications.

More than six weeks have elapsed since the Council’s recommendations were submitted to the Commission.

The Commission makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred on it by section 38(1) of the 2013 Act.

### **Title and commencement**

1.–(1) The title of this Order is the Rhondda Cynon Taf (Communities) Order 2025.

(2) This Order comes into force at the next local government election.

### **Interpretation**

words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as they have in Part 3 of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013, except so far as a contrary intention appears.

### **Local government area changes**

3. Changes are made in the local government area of the County Borough of Rhondda Cynon Taf in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.

### **Communities of Llanharan and Llantrisant – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

4. The part of the community of Llanharan which is shown shaded in pink on Map A:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Llantrisant; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Talbot Green within the community of Llantrisant; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Llantrisant and Talbot Green.

### **Communities of Llanharry and Pont-y-clun – change to community areas**

5. The community ward of Tyle-garw which is shown shaded in purple on Map B:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pont-y-clun; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Pontyclun West within the community of Pont-y-clun.

### **Communities of Llanharan and Pont-y-clun – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

6. The part of the community of Llanharan shown shaded in brown on Map C:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pont-y-clun; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Pontyclun West within the community of Pont-y-clun; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Pontyclun West.

### **Community of Llanharan – change to community ward areas**

7. The part of the community ward of Llanilid shown shaded in blue on Map D:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Llanharan.

**Community of Pont-y-clun – change to community ward areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

8. The part of the community ward of Pontyclun Central shown shaded in turquoise on Map E:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Pontyclun East; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Pontyclun East.

**Communities of Pont-y-clun and Llantrisant – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

9. The part of the community of Pont-y-clun shown shaded in yellow on Map F:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Llantrisant; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Llantrisant Town within the community of Llantrisant; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Llantrisant and Talbot Green.

10. The part of the community of Llantrisant shown shaded in purple on Map G:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pont-y-clun; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Pontyclun Central within the community of Pont-y-clun; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Pontyclun Central.

**Community of Tonyrefail – change to community ward areas**

11. The part of the community ward of Tynybryn shown shaded in yellow on Map H:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Thomastown.

**Communities of Tonyrefail and Gilfach Goch – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

12. The part of the community of Gilfach Goch shown shaded in blue on Map I:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Tonyrefail; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Thomastown within the community of Tonyrefail; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Tonyrefail West.

**Communities of Tonyrefail and Pen-y-graig – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

13. The part of the community of Tonyrefail shown shaded in green on Map J:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pen-y-graig; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Pen-y-graig.

**Communities of Tonyrefail and Cymmer– change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

14. The part of the community of Tonyrefail shown shaded in pink on Map K:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Cymmer; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Cymer.

**Communities of Ynyshir and Porth – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

15. The part of the community of Ynyshir shown shaded in turquoise on Map L:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Porth; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Porth.

**Communities of Porth and Cymmer – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

16. The part of the community of Porth shown shaded in purple on Map M:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Cymmer; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Cymer.

**Community of Cymmer- change to community name**

17. The community of Cymmer as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Cymer.

**Community of Gilfach Goch- change to community and community ward names**

**18.** The community of Gilfach Goch as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Gilfach-goch.

**19.** The community ward of Gilfach Goch as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Gilfach-goch.

**Community of Ynyshir- change to community name**

**20.** The community of Ynyshir as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Ynys-hir.

**Electoral Ward of Tylorstown and Ynyshir- change to electoral ward name**

**21.** The electoral ward of Tylorstown and Ynyshir as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the English name of Tylorstown and Ynys-hir; and
- (b) the Welsh name of Tylorstown ac Ynys-hir.

**Communities of Hirwaun and Rhigos – change to community areas**

**22.** The part of the community of Hirwaun shown shaded in pink on Map N:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Rhigos.

**23.** The part of the community of Hirwaun shown shaded in purple on Map N:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Rhigos.

**24.** The part of the community of Rhigos shown shaded in green on Map N:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Hirwaun; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Hirwaun within the community of Hirwaun.

**Communities of Hirwaun and Pen-y-waun – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**25.** The part of the community of Hirwaun shown shaded in pink on Map O:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pen-y-waun; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Pen-y-waun.

**Communities of Aberdare East and Aberdare West – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**26.** The part of the community of Aberdare East shown shaded in turquoise on Map P:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Aberdare West; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Aberdare West and Llwydcoed.

**27.** The part of the community of Aberdare West shown shaded in purple on Map Q:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Aberdare East; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Aberdare East.

**28.** The part of the community of Aberdare East shown shaded in pink on Map R:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Aberdare West; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Aberdare West and Llwydcoed.

**Communities of Aberdare East and Aberaman North – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**29.** The part of the community of Aberaman North shown shaded in turquoise on Map S:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Aberdare East; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Aberdare East.

**Communities of Aberaman South and Aberaman North – change to community areas**

**30.** The part of the community of Aberaman North shown shaded in yellow on Map T:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Aberaman South.

**Communities of Treherbert and Treorchy – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**31.** The part of the community of Treherbert shown shaded in blue on Map U:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Treorchy; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Treorchy.

**Communities of Pentre and Treorchy – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**32.** The part of the community of Pentre shown shaded in yellow on Map V:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Treorchy; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Treorchy.

**Communities of Pentre and Ystrad – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**33.** The part of the community of Pentre shown shaded in turquoise on Map W:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Ystrad; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Ystrad.

**Communities of Maerdy to Ferndale – change to community areas**

**34.** The part of the community of Maerdy shown shaded in turquoise on Map X:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Ferndale.

**Communities of Mountain Ash East and Mountain Ash West – change to community areas**

**35.** The part of the community of Mountain Ash West shown shaded in pink on Map Y:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Mountain Ash East.

**Communities of Penrhiw-ceibr and Abercynon – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**36.** The part of the community of Abercynon shown shaded in blue on Map Z:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Penrhiw-ceibr; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Penrhiw-ceibr.

**Communities of Penrhiw-ceibr and Mountain Ash West – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**37.** The part of the community of Mountain Ash West shown shaded in turquoise on Map AA:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Penrhiw-ceibr; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Penrhiw-ceibr.

**38.** The part of the community of Mountain Ash West shown shaded in purple on Map AB:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Penrhiw-ceibr; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Penrhiw-ceibr.

**Communities of Tonypandy and Llwyn-y-pia– change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**39.** The part of the community of Tonypandy shown shaded in yellow on Map AC:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Llwyn-y-pia; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Llwyn-y-pia.

**Community of Llwyn-y-pia- change to community name**

**40.** The community of Llwyn-y-pia as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Llwynypia.

**Electoral Ward of Llwyn-y-pia- change to electoral ward name**

**41.** The electoral ward of Llwyn-y-pia as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the single name of Llwynypia.

**Communities of Tonypandy and Cwm Clydach– change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**42.** The part of the community of Tonypandy shown shaded in green on Map AD:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Cwm Clydach; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Cwm Clydach.

**Communities of Pontypridd Town and Taffs Well – change to community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**43.** The part of the community of Pontypridd Town shown shaded in green on Map AE:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Taffs Well; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Nantgarw within the community of Taffs Well; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Taff's Well.

**44.** The part of the community of Taffs Well shown shaded in pink on Map AF:

- (a) is transferred to the community of Pontypridd Town; and
- (b) forms part of the community ward of Hawthorn and Lower Rhydfelen within the community of Pontypridd Town; and
- (c) forms part of the electoral ward of Hawthorn and Lower Rhydfelen.

**Community of Pontypridd Town – change to community ward areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

**45.** The part of the community ward of Hawthorn and Lower Rhydfelen shown shaded in blue on Map AG:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Upper Rhydfelen and Glyn-taf; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Upper Rhydfelen and Glyn-taf.

**46.** The part of the community ward of Upper Rhydfelen and Glyn-taf shown shaded in yellow on Map AH:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Rhydfelen Central; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Rhydfelen Central.

**47.** The part of the community ward of Rhondda shown shaded in turquoise on Map AI:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Town; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Pontypridd Town.

**Community of Taffs Well- change to community and community ward names**

**48.** The community of Taffs Well as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the English name of Taff's Well; and
- (b) the Welsh name of Ffynnon Taf.

49. The community ward of Taffs Well as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the English name of Taff's Well; and
- (b) the Welsh name of Ffynnon Taf.

**Community of Pontypridd Town - change to community ward names**

50. The community ward of Town as changed by this Order:

- (a) is given the English name of Pontypridd Town; and
- (b) the Welsh name of Tref Pontypridd.

**Community of Llantwit Fardre – change to community ward areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

51. The part of the community ward of Church Village shown shaded in pink on Map AJ:

- (a) is transferred to the community ward of Ton-teg; and
- (b) forms part of the electoral ward of Ton-teg.

**Llanharan, Llanharry, Pont-y-clun, and Tonyrefail – change in community areas and consequential changes to electoral arrangements**

52. In the community of Llanharan the number of councillors to be elected for the Brynna ward is 5, for the Llanharan ward is 5, and for the Llanilid ward is 5.

53. In the community of Llanharry the number of councillors to be elected for the Llanharry ward is 8.

54. In the community of Pont-y-clun the number of councillors to be elected for the Pontyclun central ward is 4, for the Pontyclun East ward is 4, and the Pontyclun West ward is 4.

55. In the community of Tonyrefail the number of councillors to be elected for the Coedely ward is 2, for the Collena ward is 3, for the Penrhiw-fer ward is 2, for the Thomastown ward is 2, for the Tylcha ward is 2, and for the Tynybryn ward is 3.



MAP A – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF LLANHARAN AND LLANTRISANT


Llanharan to Talbot Green Area


#### Tyle-garw to Pontyclun West Area and Llanharan to Pontyclun West Area

## MAP C – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF LLANHARAN AND PONT-Y-CLUN


### Llanharan to Pontyclun West Area

MAP D – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY WARD AREAS – COMMUNITY WARDS OF LLANILID AND LLANHARAN




Pontyclun East to Llantrisant Town Area

MAP G – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF PONT-Y-CLUN AND LLANTRISANT


Talbot Green to Pontyclun Central Area

MAP H – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY WARD AREAS – COMMUNITY WARDS OF TYNBYRYN AND THOMASTOWN


Tynybryn to Thomastown Area and Hendreforgan to Thomastown Area

MAP I – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF TONYREFAIL AND GILFACH-GOCH



**MAP J – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF TONYREFAIL AND PEN-Y-GRAIG**



MAP K – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF TONYREFAIL AND CYMER


Collena to Cymer Area

MAP L – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF YNYS-HIR AND CYMER



## MAP M – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF PORTH AND CYMER



MAP N – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF HIRWAUN AND RHIGOS


Hirwaun to Rhigos Area and Rhigos to Hirwaun Area

MAP O – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF HIRWAUN AND PEN-Y-WAUN


Hirwaun to Pen-y-waun Area

MAP Q – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF ABERDARE EAST AND ABERDARE WEST



MAP S – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF ABERDARE EAST AND ABERAMAN NORTH


Aberaman North to Aberdare East Area



MAP W – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF PENTRE AND YSTRAD



MAP X – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF MAERDY AND FERNDALE


Maerdy to Ferndale Area


Mountain Ash West to Mountain Ash East Area

## MAP Z – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF ABERCYNON AND PENRHIW-CEIBR




Mountain Ash West to Penrhiw-ceibr Area


Mountain Ash West to Penrhiw-ceibr Area

TONYPANDY AND LLWYNYPYA


Tonypandy to Llwynypia Area

MAP AD – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY AREAS – COMMUNITIES OF TONYPANDY AND CWM CLYDACH


Tonypandy to Cwm Clydach Area

Hawthorn and Lower Rhydfelen to Nantgarw Area



MAP AG – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY WARD AREAS – COMMUNITY OF PONTYPRIDD TOWN


**Hawthorn and Lower Rhydfelen to Upper Rhydfelen and Glyn-taf Area**

MAP AH – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY WARD AREAS – COMMUNITY OF PONTYPRIDD TOWN


Upper Rhydfelen and Glyn-taf to Rhydfelen Central Area

MAP AI – CHANGES TO COMMUNITY WARD AREAS – COMMUNITY OF PONTYPRIDD TOWN


Rhondda to Pontypridd Town Area

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order, made in accordance with section 38(1) of the Democracy and Boundary Commission Cymru etc. Act 2013 (“the 2013 Act”), gives effect to recommendations made by Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council (“the Council”). The Council reported in April 2025 on its review under section 25 of the 2013 Act of community boundaries.

The report recommended changes to the boundaries of the communities of Aberaman North, Aberaman South, Abercynon, Aberdare East, Aberdare West, Cwm Clydach, Cymmer, Ferndale, Gilfach Goch, Hirwaun, Llanharan, Llanharry, Llantrisant, Llantwit Fardre, Llwynypia, Maerdy, Mountain Ash East, Mountain Ash West, Penrhiw-ceibr, Pentre, Pen-y-graig, Pen-y-waun, Pont-y-clun, Pontypidd Town, Porth, Rhigos, Taffs Well, Tonypany, Tonyrefail, Treherbert, Treorchy, Ynyshir, and Ystrad. This order makes changes to the boundaries of those communities.

The report recommended changes to the names of communities and electoral wards, the recommended names have been given in the maps.
